No	Clause in FIDIC Red Book 1987 edn	Comments
1	Sub-clause 1.1 (Definitions)	The Employer can replace the Engineer at its own discretion.
2	Sub-clause 2.5 (Instructions in Writing)	Should the Engineer's Instruction constitute to a variation, it will be redrafted.
3	Sub-clause 5.2 (Priority of Contract Documents)	In the case of discrepancy in the documents the Engineer shall clarify the intent.
4	Sub-clause 22.1 (Damage to Persons and Property)	The Engineer is insured by the Contractor under its insurance.
5	Sub-clause 26.1 (Compliance with Statues, Regulations)	The Engineer shall be responsible for liaison with the appropriate authority.
6	Sub-clause 40.3 (Suspension lasting more than 84 Days)	Changed to Suspension Lasting more than 186 days.
7	Sub-clause 45.1 (Restriction on Working Hours)	The cost of over time to be paid by the Contractor.
8	Sub-clause 46.1 (Rate of Progress)	Any part of the Contractor's scope can be taken out and allocated to another contractor to complete. The reduction in the Contract Price, as amended pursuant to the Contract, shall be decided by the Engineer.
9	Sub-clause 48.1 (Taking-Over Certificate)	The Contractor shall furnish the Engineer for his approval with Operating & maintenance instructions and details together with a full set of drawings in sufficient detail to maintain, dismantle, and re-assemble all parts of the works.
10	Sub-clause 52.3 (Variations Exceeding 15 percent)	This sub-clause is deleted in its entirety.
11	Clause 60 (Certificates and Payment)	Time for certification and time for payment are modified.
12	Sub-clause 65.9 (Termination for Convenience)	A recently introduced clause that favours the Employer. (Alternatively, added under the Clause 63 – Remedies)
